### **Town Hall Meeting immediately following.**

Questions were raised: How do we get more people to play golf? Not only in our community but bring in outside players.

Could the cost of play be reduced if we changed days? Mike said no.

What happens when over seeding happens and 4 associations have to play all on the same day? (One course not useable) that has been a problem in the past.

Some members expressed that they already play with other leagues – HOA 1 or the 18ers. They find switching to the one they want is not an issue and others could do the same.

Some members wanted to know why this was even an issue to begin with since we have played on Tuesdays for the past 25 years. Helen answered that because we had sent out a questionnaire for the Retention and Recruitment committee on how to increase membership and keep members. Changing the day of play was one of the comments from many members and therefore it was brought to the membership.

The earliest this change – if voted for by the membership – would go into effect would be January 2026.

Mike stated several times that it seemed many Niners were happy to keep the same day of play. That was fine.
